It is a great practice to thank those who have contributed to our success in 4-H. We want to raise thankful young people. We want 4-H'ers to understand that there is a sacrifice behind the plaque, award, or time donated by a caring individual or project helper. Therefore, to complete your 4-H project this year, 4-Hers must follow the directions listed below. Immediately following project judging, 4-Hers will show their thank you note to a key volunteer to make sure that the draft is complete.

Directions: Write a thank you note to an important person who helped you with your project. This can be an advisor, parent, grandparent, someone or somewhere you job shadow, or anyone else who may have helped.

Don't forget to include these parts of a Thank You Note

- Date
- Greeting & recipient's name
- Thank them for something specific they did or taught you
- Thank them for a skill or lesson
- Talk about how they helped with the completion of your project
- Closing
- Signature
- Club name
