### General 4-H Project

- ✿ Member MUST participate in County Project/Interview Judging or 4-H Project will be INCOMPLETE.
  - ✿ Member must attend **General 4-H Project Judging Day** to be eligible for County Placement and State Fair Selection (if applicable).
  - ✿ If the member cannot attend Project Judging, your project can be judged at Early Judging. However, Early Judging participants will not qualify for County Placement or State Fair.
  - ✿ Project must be displayed at the Ross County Fair to receive fair premiums.

#### **Completion:**

1. All 8 activities
  - be sure to complete a Capstone Project (Activity 8 – pg.34)
2. At least 2 learning experiences
3. At least 2 citizenship activities
4. Prepare an educational exhibit (notebook or scrapbook) based on your Capstone project. Include resources and other information you gathered to complete your project.

#### **Judging:**

1. Interview based on skills learned, activities completed, and educational display.
2. Bring to interview on General 4-H Project Judging Day:
  - a. Completed project book
  - b. Capstone educational project

#### **County Fair Exhibit:**

Display your Capstone educational project.

#### **State Fair Competition:**

1. State Fair participants will be selected during county-level competition on General 4-H Project Judging Day.
2. Event: Leadership Day
  - Completed project book, \*display, and interview
  - \*Display – a table-top exhibit illustrating highlights of project experiences and accomplishments; exhibit is limited to 36" wide by 24" deep tabletop space.
