General 4-H Project

- ✿ Member **MUST** participate in County Project/Interview Judging or 4-H Project will be **INCOMPLETE**.
- ✿ Member must attend **General 4-H Project Judging Day** to be eligible for County Placement and State Fair Selection (if applicable).
- ✿ If the member cannot attend Project Judging, your project can be judged at Early Judging. However, Early Judging participants will not qualify for County Placement or State Fair.
- ✿ Project must be displayed at the Ross County Fair to receive fair premiums.

Skill Level: Advanced. Can use Film or Digital, Adjustable Lens Camera. Additional equipment such as wide angle and telephoto lenses, filters, and light meter is useful.

Completion:

1. At least 2 activities in each of the 4 project areas
2. All "Talking It Over" questions
3. At least 2 Learning Experiences
4. At least 2 Leadership/Citizenship activities
5. Photo Journal or Scrapbook
6. *If repeating project, use same book for 1–3 years*

Judging:

1. Interview based on skills learned, activities completed and educational exhibit.
2. Bring to interview on General 4-H Project Judging Day:
 - a. Completed project book
 - b. Photo Journal or Scrapbook
 - c. Display
 - i. single mounted print
 - ii. prints that tell a "photo story"
 - iii. prints that illustrate an activity
 - iv. single print with the news story it illustrates

County Fair Exhibit:

Display photo exhibit in a fair booth.

State Competition – Level 3:

1. State Fair participants will be selected during county-level competition on General 4-H Project Judging Day.
2. Event: Photography Day.
Completed project book, *display, interview
*Display – participant is required to bring ONE of the following for exhibit
 - a. single mounted print
 - b. prints that tell a "photo story"
 - c. prints that illustrate an activity
 - d. single print with the news story it illustrates
