

#135-C – GOAT: COMPANION PET

General 4-H Project

- ✿ Member **MUST** participate in County Project/Interview Judging or 4-H Project will be **INCOMPLETE**.
- ✿ Member must attend **General 4-H Project Judging Day** to be eligible for County Placement and State Fair Selection (if applicable).
- ✿ If the member cannot attend Project Judging, your project can be judged at Early Judging. However, Early Judging participants will not qualify for County Placement or State Fair.
- ✿ Project must be displayed at the Ross County Fair to receive fair premiums.

Notes:

1. The animal used for **COMPANION PET GOAT** **MAY NOT BE SHOWN** at the Junior Fair as a breeding, market, dairy, or pygmy goat project.
2. Companion Pet Goat project #135-C members are **NOT** required to complete Quality Assurance or Skillathon.
3. The "Goat Resource Handbook" is a resource for this project.

Completion:

1. At least 1 topic of interest (page 8)
2. Project Summary (page 9)
3. At least 2 Learning Activities
4. At least 2 Learning Experiences
5. At least 2 Leadership/Citizenship activities
6. Prepare an educational exhibit based on this project (item made from project book, photo exhibit, notebook, scrapbook or poster (minimum 14" x 22" and maximum 22" x 28")).

Judging:

1. Interview over project and record book, completed activities and general project knowledge.
2. Bring completed project book and an educational exhibit to interview on General 4-H Project Judging Day.
3. Do NOT BRING COMPANION GOAT to county judging. Due to potential animal stress (heat, transporting, etc.), please do NOT bring animal to judging.

County Fair Exhibit:

An educational display relating to project work must be displayed in a fair booth.

State Fair Competition: NO state fair activity for this project.
