COMPLETION:

1. Follow Ross County 4-H Project and Show Rules and Regulations for current 4-H program year.
2. Follow *Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows*
3. First-time participants must complete “Horse Safety Program”
4. Complete (when enroll in project in 4honline) “Permission to Participate in Participate in 4-H Horse Activities Disclosure & Release of Claims’ Form
5. Complete your project book following the General Project Guidelines
 - a. First year - complete records in the book
Additional years – complete Project Record Supplement
 - b. Attach a feed label or list of ingredients in your custom mix.
 - c. Complete Things to Do in each interest area
 - d. Complete at least 2 Leadership/Citizenship activities & 2 Learning Experiences
 - e. Questions on page 55-57
 - f. Complete judging description of your horse
 - g. Completed *190R Equine Record Book*

JUDGING:

1. **By June 1** – Enter Horse by completing & returning: ‘Horse ID & Registration’ Form
2. **By July 1** - ‘Horse Show Class’ Form (Light Horse Selection class for your age division)
3. Participate in Horse Skillathon (Thursday before Fair starts)
Bring Project Book with completed records or Record Supplement Book to Skillathon
4. Participate in Light Horse Selection class, in your age division, at the Ross County Junior Fair Horse Show:
