 - ✿ If the member cannot make Project Judging, your project can be judged at Early Judging. However, Early Judging participants will not qualify for County Placement or State Fair.
 - ✿ Project must be displayed at the Ross County Fair to receive fair premiums.

#188 – Trail Riding**COMPLETION:**

1. Have access to a horse.
2. Follow Ross County 4-H Project and Show Rules and Regulations for current 4-H program year.
3. Follow *Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows*
4. First-time participants must complete "Horse Safety Program"
5. Explore all interest areas
6. Complete at least 2 Things to Do
7. At least 2 project Learning Activities and 2 Leadership/Citizenship activities
8. Complete *190R Equine Record Book*
9. Write a one-page summary and attach to book
10. Prepare an educational exhibit (item made from project book, photo exhibit, notebook, scrapbook or poster; poster size minimum 14" x 22" and maximum 22" x 28") based on this project.

JUDGING:

1. Member will be interviewed on knowledge gained in this project.
2. Bring completed project book, one-page summary and educational exhibit or poster to the interview.

FAIR EXHIBIT:

Display educational exhibit relating to project work in a fair booth.
