Eligibility:

1. Attained the academic rank of high school “senior”
2. Minimum GPA of 2.5
3. Current Ross County 4-H member
4. Attending any post-secondary college/university next year
5. Participate in leading Carteens programming for at least one year

Application:

1. Current transcript of your grades
2. A one-page letter of support from your academic advisor, guidance counselor, teacher, community leader, or employer
3. A two-page, single-sided, double-spaced story on a Carteens topic that has personally impacted your life.
4. Complete application and turn in hard copy to Extension office by January 15, 2021

Selection Criteria:

- 30% application & 4-H experiences
- 30% personal story
- 20% letter of support
- 20% financial need
