### How to Get to 4-H Camp without Getting Lost in Tar Hollow

Cell Phones do <u>NOT</u> work in the Tar Hollow area!

And GPS will send you to the <u>wrong</u> camping section of the park.

Follow these easy directions...

- From Chillicothe, take US Rt. 50 East
- Turn North (left) on SR 327 at Londonderry
- Stay on SR 327 until you come to the really big "Tar Hollow State Park" sign (you will go past the Ranger Station sign)
- Turn Left at the "Tar Hollow State Park" sign
- After entering the Park, follow the signs marked "RESIDENT CAMP" Look for the 4-H Clover signs

#### STUFF TO BRING -

#### **© CLOTHING**

Dress for the weather! Wear what is comfortable and what you can get dirty & messy. No "good" clothes.

## © WEAR TENNIS SHOES!

Tennis shoes only!

NO sandals or
open-toe shoes.
For safety reasons,
children need to wear
tennis shoes. Campers
will be very active and
must wear shoes at all
times.

DO NOT SEND CELL PHONES, electronics, or valuable items.

Cell phones do not work in Tar Hollow.

### **CHECK IN and CHECK OUT**

You can help the day go smoothly-

#### CHECK IN— 9:30 am

- 1. PARK IN FRONT OF LODGE & ENTER FRONT PORCH
- 2. **SEE THE NURSE**—Each adult & camper(s) will stop by nurse
  - Camper

     will get their picture taken
  - Adult Sign COVID Acknowledgement; and if needed, will update health form or turn in medications (see med policy)
- 4. **REGISTER**—An adult MUST sign in each camper.
  - Meet your counselors (campers assigned to small groups)
- 5. **RETURN TO VEHICLE**. CAMPER STAYS & PARENTS ARE FREE until pick-up time at 3:30 pm.

Parent/guardian leaves—sorry, no chit chat with old friends.

### CHECK OUT—3:30 pm

- 1. Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes early.
- 2. **WAIT OUTSIDE** in vehicles until we announce we are ready to go (when all campers are inside).

Then adults will line-up outside in front

3. **SIGN-OUT.** Parents will <u>ENTER</u>, <u>SIGN OUT</u> their camper, and <u>then go over to the counselor</u> to pick up camper. All campers must be signed out by an adult before being released!

## **MEDICATION POLICY**

#### FOR ALL MEDICATIONS BROUGHT TO CAMP

- Give <u>ALL medications</u> to the Camp Nurse at registration. Bring only exact amount needed!
- 2. **In a zip-type baggie:** place medication & directions. Write child's name & staple a photo of child on the baggie.
  - Prescription Medications: <u>MUST be in the container in which they were issued</u> with label, medical orders and physician's name intact. Others will not be accepted!
  - Over-the-Counter Medications: <u>MUST be</u> in the original container with label attached.
    Others will not be accepted!
  - Epi-Pen: If participant has an allergy that may require the use of an "EPI-PEN", then participant MUST provide it. At check-in, alert Camp Nurse that camper will be carrying an Epi-pen. (Epi-pens are NOT provided by camp)
- Medications will be given as directed on the original package/container. If there are any dosage adjustments, you must bring signed documentation from your physician.



## <u>THINGS TO KNOW</u>

<u>CASHLESS CAMP</u>: Campers <u>will not need any money</u> as crafts, snacks, a camp t-shirt, etc, are included in the camp fee.

<u>VISITORS</u>: Since this is a one-day camp, we understand travel time may be a burden and that you may want to stay in the area until camp dismisses. However, we ask that parents, grandparents, guardians, <u>not stay</u> with the camper as they participate in camp. You may wish to find a separate area of the park to relax, read a book or enjoy the scenery during camp time. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter as this *greatly* alleviates homesickness and disruption of both the campers & the camp schedule.

**LEAVING CAMP:** For safety reasons, and so everyone can enjoy the entire 4-H camp experience, <u>campers will NOT</u> be allowed to arrive late or come & go from camp. We enjoy having each camper fully participate from start to closing!

**CAMPER RULES:** Cloverbuds have simple responsibilities while at camp, including:

- Campers will help keep camp clean.
- Counselors will set & clear the tables and campers will clean their eating area.
- Campers may not leave the campgrounds without the Camp Director's permission.
- Campers are to respect & protect each other, the camp property, and the property of others.
- Campers taking medication must report to the Nurse. The Nurse will retain and administer the medication as prescribed.
- Weapons, fireworks and/or fire of any type are prohibited. This is a State Law in the Park.
- There will be NO SWIMMING for Cloverbud campers.
- NO CELL PHONES or ELECTRONICS are allowed.

FAILURE TO OBEY RULES is cause for immediate dismissal without refund of Camping Fees.
