- Must have a High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Enrolled as a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior at any accredited college, university, technical or trade school
  - Graduate Students will be considered with preference going to undergraduate students
- Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.5 or better
- Any academic major acceptable

#### Selection Procedures and Criteria

In addition to Ross County 4-H Scholarship eligibility requirements, applicants must:

- Be a former Ross County 4-H/FFA participant for a minimum of 5 years
- have completed a Ross County 4-H/FFA animal project (any animal) for a minimum of 3 years
