CAMP REGISTRATION

1. PICK YOUR CAMP

Sign up for the camp according to the grade the child is in now (school year 2022/2023). Camps are first-come, first-served; limited space. All camps are held at Tar Hollow State Park Resident Camp

2. FILL OUT ONLINE REGISTRATION

Child's registration will not be complete unless ALL FORMS are FILLED out.

At camp, we oversee 150-200 camp go-ers. In the event of an emergency, the first thing we do is grab these forms. We rely on the information you provide to help us navigate your child's needs to both prevent and respond to emergency situations. It is vital that you include everything so that we can best ensure camp is a safe place!

CAMP FAQ'S

CAN MY FRIEND BE IN MY CABIN?

Yes! A camper may request 1 cabin mate and 1 alternate. TO be in the same cabin, BOTH campers must request each other!

NOTE We do not guarantee cabin requests due to limited cabin size and the number of campers. However, we do make every effort to house a camper with one friend.

CAN I BRING MY CELLPHONE?

No! The Ohio State University Electronic Policy is strictly enforced! Electronics (including cellphones) are NOT ALLOWED at camp. Do NOT send or pack or try to hide phone/electronics. Please note that there is NO cell phone service in Tar Hollow.

WHEN IS THE REFUND DEADLINE?

May 15 – We are unable to give refunds after 4:00 pm due to prepaid camp expenses (food, insurance, t-shirt, etc.)

CAMP BASICS

LOCATION: All camps are held at Tar Hollow Resident Camp located east of Chillicothe (near Londonderry) in the beautiful hills of Tar Hollow State Park

CAMP FEE: The camp fee includes meals, a camp t-shirt, insurance, and programming. Campers may want to bring extra money for the canteen or crafts. PLEASE send \$1 & \$5 bills only – we do not have change for big bills.

CABINS: Each cozy, rustic cabin sleeps up to 7 campers plus 1-2 counselors. Campers are housed by gender provided on forms. Boys and girls reside on separate hills. Each hill has its own restroom and shower house.

MEALS: Nutritious and delicious meals are served family-style and include a salad/breakfast bar.

EARLY ARRIVAL/LATE DISMISSAL: For safety and camp programming reasons we want campers to enjoy the entire 4-H camping experience. Therefore, campers will NOT be permitted to arrive late or leave and come back. We enjoy having each camper fully participate from the start of camp to the closing of camp.

CANTEEN: Stop by the camp canteen for awesome camp stuff! Prices range from 50¢ - \$15.00 for items like yummy snacks, ice cream, camp spirit wear and merchandise (again, small bills please!)

CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS: Funds are available to help reduce camp fees for those who qualify. Scholarship applications are available as an optional component of the online camp registration form. Supporting documentation must be attached.

VISITORS: Parents/family are welcome to look around when bringing their 4-Her to camp. While camp is in progress, PERSONAL VISITORS are not permitted since this disrupts the camp schedule and camp making both campers and parents homesick. This also limits the in and out of traffic in the camp area.

CONDUCT: For the health, safety, and welfare of all participants, campers must read and comply with camp rules. Failure to obey the rules is cause for immediate dismissal without refund of camp fees.
