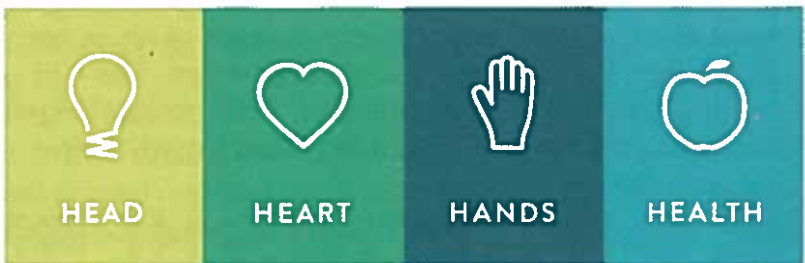


Ross County 4-H



What is 4-H?

4-H is a community of young people across America who are learning leadership, citizenship, and life skills as they work in partnership with caring adults. We want to empower all youth to reach their full potential by letting them participate in hands-on learning.

4-H represents four leaves of a clover:

Head — clearer thinking, decision-making, and knowledge that is useful throughout life

Heart — greater loyalty, strong personal values, positive self-concept and concern for others

Hands — service, workforce preparedness, useful skills, science and technical literacy

Health — better living and healthy lifestyle choices

What's it look like?

4-H is **community club** and **project-based**. Your child would join a group of people and attend meetings with agendas, officers, a constitution, and by-laws. Meetings include activities that work on leadership, community service and career exploration and happen almost every



month. Each club decides when and where to meet on their own, likely a school, church, or home. Your child selects a project and works on it all year with the support of his or her fellow club members and adult volunteer advisors. The 4-H program runs from Fall through Summer. Final project judging and exhibition occurs in July and at the Ross County Fair.

Who can participate?

4-H membership is based on a child's age AND grade as of January 1 of the current calendar year. Eligibility for Cloverbud participation begins when a child is age 5 and enrolled in kindergarten. Eligibility

for participation in 4-H projects and competitive events begins when a child is age 8 and in third grade. Any youth age 9 or above is eligible for project membership, regardless of grade level. A youth's 4-H eligibility ends December 31 the year he or she turns 19. We always love new members!

What are projects you can take?

There are tons of types of 4-H projects! Fishing, cooking, sewing, robotics, pet animals, livestock animals, shooting sports, leadership, and even self-determined. There are over 200 types of projects to check out www.ohio4h.org/familyguide

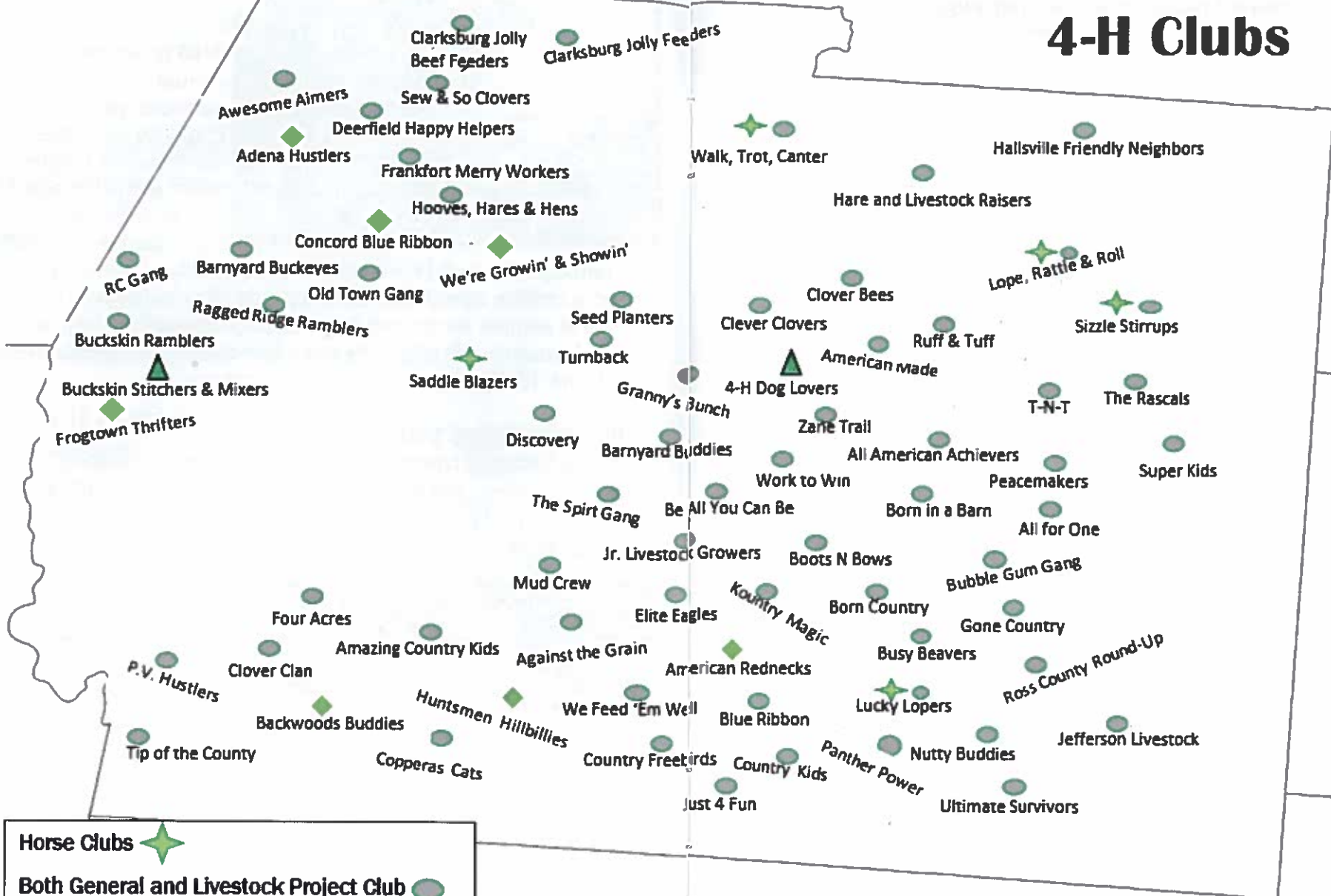
How to join?

Enrollment deadline is March 1. Club advisors must have all enrollments (including member information and project selections) by this deadline. Interested families should contact the Extension Office or club advisors in the late fall or early winter.
